## MONDAY

<b>Reading</b>	Read books on <a href="#">Epic Books</a> for 30 minutes.
<b>Math</b>	Complete math on <a href="#">Happy Numbers</a> for 30 minutes.
<b>Writing</b>	Write an <b>informational paragraph</b> about exercise. You can use the book <a href="#">Healthy Living: Exercise on Epic!</a> to help you.
<b>Expedition</b>	Earlier this year, we learned that there are many ways people can get their voices heard and stand up for what is right. Make a sign or a poster about something that is important to you. Share it with your teacher or someone at home.
<b>Art</b>	A portrait is an artwork of a person, usually depicting (showing) the face. Make a portrait of someone you love. You can try to make it look like the person or you can use symbols to represent the person and how you feel about them. A symbol is an object that represents or stands for something else like an idea. What does a heart symbolize? What are other symbols you can think of?
<b>PE</b>	50 Front and Back Jumps! (Pretend like you are jumping over a line or a hurdle.)
<b>Optional</b>	Write a <b>silly story</b> using these words:  <b>brave    jump    three    might    some</b>

## TUESDAY

<b>Reading</b>	Read books on <a href="#">Epic Books</a> for 30 minutes.
<b>Math</b>	Complete math on <a href="#">Happy Numbers</a> for 30 minutes.
<b>Writing</b>	Read the book <a href="#">Friends</a> on Epic. Write an <b>opinion paragraph</b> about someone you know who is a good friend and explain what makes that person a good friend.
<b>Expedition</b>	Do you remember when we learned about what happens to our trash? A lot of it ends up in landfills! We also learned that many things can be recycled or reused. Talk to someone at home about how you can reuse or recycle something. You can use the book <a href="#">How I Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle</a> to help.
<b>Art</b>	Yesterday you made a portrait of someone else. Today you are going to create a self-portrait (a portrait of you) by looking in the mirror. Try to notice details like any freckles, jewelry and hairstyle. Remember everyone has a different style of drawing. Let your drawing style come through!
<b>PE</b>	Do a standing long jump 10 times! Stand in one spot and jump as far as you can. Measure it or place a marker so you can try to beat your record!
<b>Optional</b>	<b>Draw a picture of your home.</b> Add as much detail as you can!

## WEDNESDAY

<b>Reading</b>	Read books on <a href="#">Epic Books</a> for 30 minutes.
<b>Math</b>	Complete math on <a href="#">Happy Numbers</a> for 30 minutes.
<b>Writing</b>	Write an <b>informational paragraph</b> about Black Bears! You can use <a href="#">this book about black bears</a> to help you.
<b>Expedition</b>	Read this book called <a href="#">Healthy Living</a> and tell your family <b>three</b> facts you learned about vegetables!!
<b>Art</b>	Last week you made a still life with some of your toys. Today you are going to make a still life using objects that represent you. Find objects that are important to you such as favorite toys, food, or sports equipment, or an Alma Del Mar crew shirt and arrange them in a way you think looks interesting. Draw or take a picture of the still life.
<b>PE</b>	50 Scissor jumps! One foot in front and one foot behind you and switch your feet 50 times!

<b>Reading</b>	Read books on <a href="#">Epic Books</a> for 30 minutes.
<b>Math</b>	Complete math on <a href="#">Happy Numbers</a> for 30 minutes.
<b>Writing</b>	Write an opinion paragraph about your favorite <b>fruit</b> or <b>vegetable</b> ! Don't forget to include 3 or more <b>reasons</b> why you love it!
<b>Expedition</b>	We have learned a lot about growing gardens! Today you are going to read <a href="#">a book all about growing watermelons</a> ! After you read make sure to tell someone in your house the different steps you need to grow watermelon!
<b>Art</b>	Make a self-portrait using unexpected materials. Artists have created portraits and self-portraits made from everything from candy to bottle caps. Check with your grown up to see what materials you can use that you might have around your house. Are you super sweet? Maybe you could use sugar or cookie packaging. Do you love to make art? Perhaps you could use crayons. You can use a mixture of found objects and drawing.

<b>Art</b>	Exquisite corpse a.k.a. Picture Consequences. This is based on a game that the Surrealist artists played. You will need to ask a couple of people in your house to help you with this. Fold your paper into three sections - horizontally. The first

person draws a head and then folds it back so it can not be seen. The next person draws the midsection/torso and folds it over again. The final person draws the legs. The idea is to use your imagination. The sections of the body can be person-like, animal-like, or even robot-like. It is up to each player to create something they think is interesting. When everyone has added a section, open up the drawing to see your collaborative creation!


